MARYLAND ENACTS SAME-SEX MARRIAGE EQUALITY

The Maryland Senate gave final approval to a marriage equality bill during the last week in February, and days later, Maryland Governor Martin O'Malley signed the legislation into law. The governor signed the new law surrounded by the state's eight openly gay and lesbian lawmakers. Thus, Maryland joined seven other states and the District of Columbia in allowing same-sex couples to marry.

In his speech on the Senate floor earlier in the legislative process, openly gay State Sen. Richard Madaleno explained the value of the legislation to him and to his family, saying, "It is the marriage license that symbolizes the commitment. It makes it worthwhile. I want that marriage license in the state of Maryland."

FORMER GOP CHAIR APOLOGIZES FOR PAST ANTI-GAY MARRIAGE STANCE

Ken Mehlman, who managed George W. Bush's 2004 re-election campaign, is explicitly apologizing to the people hurt by the anti- gay marriage tone of the campaign. Mehlman, who came out as gay in 2010, said: "I am sorry" for anti-gay campaigns. At a personal level, I wish I had spoken out against the effort. As I've been involved in the fight for marriage equality, one of the things I've learned is how many people were harmed by the campaigns in which I was involved. I apologize to them and tell them I am sorry." Backing gay marriage increasingly, Mehlman continued, "is a net positive for winning elections."

The law's opponents have already begun a drive to repeal the measure, and the outcome could hinge on voter turnout this November. If the opponents gather enough signatures to put the same-sex law to a voter referendum, Governor O'Malley said he will campaign hard to retain the law. If, on the other hand, votes approve what has been enacted into law, couples could begin marrying in January, 2013.

African-American votes could be affected by President Barack Obama's position on the issue, according to one Marylander.
