

TRANS*

What's the asterisk about?

One of the challenges of my being transsexual is trying to educate and explain to people about what that means. The language itself seems to struggle at times with the pronouns and terms. Too often the very words end up clinical, and unnatural. People don't like polysyllabic words!

As I met other people, they would use the word 'trans' to represent an aspect of themselves. Originally, I wasn't a fan of this usage. It is too close to a term that I don't think will ever be 'reclaimed.' And for me, I identify as a woman, not 'trans' even though I was born male. However, as I heard it used more, it made more sense.

When I first saw in text the term 'trans*' I started looking around for some footnotes. But I think that's part of the intention. The term 'trans' doesn't cover all the very diverse ways people express their gender identity any more than 'gay' can cover all the ways people express their orientation.

The term 'trans*' is a way to acknowledge that there are many many ways to express gender, more than can even fit in our plethora of terms. Rather than to list transgender, transsexual, gender nonconforming, intersex, we put the asterisk to remind ourselves that we need to mentally have that footnote, and include the whole spectrum.

A report in Pediatric in 1998 stated that gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender youth have about a three times higher rate of attempted suicide than the general youth population. Studies also suggest that the coming out experience of 50% of GLBT teens was very negative and 25% were kicked out of their homes.

PFLAG's mission is to promote the health and well-being of gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender persons, their families and friends through

Support - support to cope with an adverse society,

Education - to enlighten an ill-informed public, and

Advocacy - to end discrimination and secure equal civil rights.
