## BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA CONSIDERS LIFTING BAN ON GAY MEMBERS AND GAY LEADERS

When the national board of directors of the Boy Scouts of America meets in Washington D.C. next week, the board might announce lifting its long-standing ban on admitting gay members and gay leaders.

The anticipated change in policy at the organization's national level comes only months after the BSA's executive board affirmed its ban on gays, stating last July that the ban was "the best policy for the organization."

A grassroots movement at the local chapter level is attributed with bringing about the anticipated change in policy, along with a broader social change evident in the last presidential election, during which both candidates, President Obama and Mitt Romney, agreed that gays should be admitted to the organization as members and as leaders.

In addition, about 50 local United Way groups and several corporations and charities have concluded that the ban violates their non-discrimination requirements and have ceased providing financial aid to the Boy Scouts. An official of The Human Rights Campaign, an advocate for gay rights, said HRC planned to downgrade its non-discrimination ratings for corporations that continue to give the BSA financial support.

If the ban at the national level is lifted, local sponsoring organizations would then have the option of admitting gay members and leaders. "The chartered organizations that oversee and deliver scouting would accept membership and select leaders consistent with their organization's mission, principles or religious beliefs," according to Deron Smith, a spokesman for the Boy Scouts' national organization.

Individual sponsors and parents "would be able to choose a local unit which best meets the needs of their families," Smith said.
