

I in 3 LGBT individuals in the US doesn't have health insurance. Which means LGBT people are likely to be sicker, wait to get tested or treated for most illnesses and suffer more serious complications when they do get sick. In the past it's has been hard to find coverage that treats our families fairly, covers the care we need and doesn't break the bank.

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) can increase coverage in our community by making health insurance more affordable, standardizing basic care and eliminating the exclusions that hurt the LGBT community the most.

On behalf of the Board of PFLAG Door County, I thank you for your support of our organization. This is the group's second general request to the community and PFLAG membership. We need your financial support! PFLAG does have 501(c)(3) non-profit status and all contributions to PFLAG are tax deductible as allowed by law.

PFLAG - Door County (Parents, Families and Friends of Lesbians and Gays) was formed 16 years ago because of a local young gay man who thought he was alone and was considering suicide. He wasn't alone. He also wasn't the only gay person who felt alone or considered suicide. A report in Pediatric in 1998 stated that gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender youth have about a three times higher rate of attempted suicide than the general youth population. Studies also suggest that the coming out experience of 50% of GLBT teens was very negative and 25% were kicked out of their homes.

PFLAG's mission is to promote the health and well-being of gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender persons, their families and friends through

Support - support to cope with an adverse society,

Education - to enlighten an ill-informed public, and

Advocacy - to end discrimination and secure equal civil rights.

PFLAG provides opportunities to dialogue about sexual orientation and gender identity and acts to create a society that is healthy and respectful of human diversity. PFLAG is not affiliated with any ethnic, religious, or political group.
