

Dear Friends,

PFLAG Door County greatly appreciates your support, and we appeal to you, once again, during our third community-wide financial campaign.

PFLAG (Parents, Families and Friends of Lesbians and Gays) Door County formed 17 years ago from the depths of the crushing emotional pain and apparent solitude of a local gay man contemplating suicide. And when he realized he was not alone, the organization was born.

He was not the only gay person who thought he was alone and who contemplated suicide. A 1998 report in <u>Pediatric</u> revealed a startling statistic: gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender you have about a three times higher rate of attempted suicide than the general population of youth. Studies also suggest that the coming-out experience of half of GLBT teens was very negative and fully one quarter of them were abandoned by their families and turned out of their homes.

PFLAG's mission: Promote the health and well-being of gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender persons, their families, and their friends through

Support – to cope with an adverse society,

Education – to enlighten an ill-informed public, and

Advocacy – to end discrimination and secure equal civil rights.

PFLAG provides opportunities to discuss sexual orientation and gender identity and acts to create a society that is healthy and respectful of human diversity.

But we cannot perform our mission without your support! With your help, this year's contributions will go to support the recent development of high school gay straight alliance activities and the presentation of *Gen Silent* at the Door County Senior Resource Center. A gender identity is personal. If someone chooses to come out to you as trans* this means they trust you. Make sure to honour that trust by checking with them before telling anyone else as they may not want others to know.

Real Name?

Asking someone what their real name is implies that their chosen name is in some way invalid or not real. In the same way, asking someone what their real gender is disrespects their own gender identity.

It is important to respect the names and pronouns that people prefer. If you are unsure, simply ask 'What are your preferred pronouns?'

Show Your Support!

Make sure to show your support for your trans* friends by challenging transphobia when you see it.

Gender Identity is not Sexual Identity

Remember that, no matter how someone identifies their own gender, they may still identify with any sexual identify. Everyone has a sexual and a gender identify, and they are seperate and distinct from each other.
